

FIVE THEMES OF GEOGRAPHY

Objective: You have spent time learning about the Five Themes of Geography in class. Now your task is to make a visual that can stand on its own and define each of the themes with limited words. *This is a test of your creativity skills.*

Assignment: You are to take the poster board that you have been given and use it to make a visual reference for the Five Themes of Geography. Your task is to scour magazines, newspapers, internet, etc. to find pictures that you can use to represent each theme. Once you have selected the pictures that you would like to work with you can put the assignment together.

Requirements:

1. You need to find two pictures for each of the Five Themes of Geography that you feel best express the definition of each theme (*Location, Character, Human and Environmental Interaction, Movement, and Region*).

Example....

Location:	
PIC #1	PIC #2
Explanation of how the pic(s) define the Theme.	

You should write a one-sentence explanation of how each selected picture helps to visually define the Theme they are attached to.

Be sure that the pictures that you select for each theme are the best pics available, not just the first ones that you find!

2. This is the first “creative” assignment I have asked you to make, please take that into account (meaning it is never too early to impress a teacher)!
3. Use your space well. Understand that you only have a small area to produce your information on, so you must plan accordingly (yes, you may use the back side)!

Grading:

This assignment is worth 30 points! 5 points for each section done correctly (labeled, 2 pics, and a brief explanation of how the picture(s) define the theme) plus 5 point for showmanship [total 30].
