## SE Asia: Exploring 5 Themes/Issues

We have begun to work with the region of SE Asia, and a few of its regional issues. This project will give you an opportunity to explore a country within the region and some of its unique issues.

<u>Objective</u>: You will explore the "Five Themes" of geography for a specific country in the region of SE Asia, and create an "issue" based research project/presentation based on your findings.

## <u> 5 Themes Visual Aid [suggestion – PP or Google Slides but could be a poster]:</u>

- 1. You will select a country from SE Asia to work with for this project. Make sure that you are comfortable with the issue attached to the country you have chosen.
- 2. You should clearly define the following for your country: **Location, Character, Human and Environmental Interaction, Movement, and Region**. You will do this by creating a BIG visual for the information retrieved from your research on the country's 5 Themes.
- 3. Be ready to spend 5-8 minutes explaining the visual that you have created, and your research problem/issue in the next section.

## **Issues**:

- 1. You will need to research current problems/issues that your country is having in either the social, political, or environmental arena.
- 2. As you begin to define and understand the problem/issue that your country is dealing with you will answer a set of questions in the form of a research paper.
- 3. Questions to answer:
  - What caused this problem in my country?
  - Why is it getting worse (how did it get this bad)?
  - What is being done to try and fix the country (who is helping)?
  - Is there hope in the future for my country (be specific)?
- 4. You will end your research paper with a conclusion that clearly states you opinion about the problem and how it is being dealt with.

## **Countries and Issues:**

- India, China, Japan, Sri Lanka, North Korea, South Korea, Vietnam, Taiwan, Myanmar, Thailand, Mongolia, Pakistan, New Guinea, Nepal, Indonesia, Bangladesh, Bhutan, Laos, Cambodia, and Malaysia.
- Regional issues generally fall into 3 different categories:
  - 1. Environmental (ex... Strip mining/logging)
  - 2. Social (ex... Human rights violations)
  - 3. Political (ex... Oppression/Dictators)
